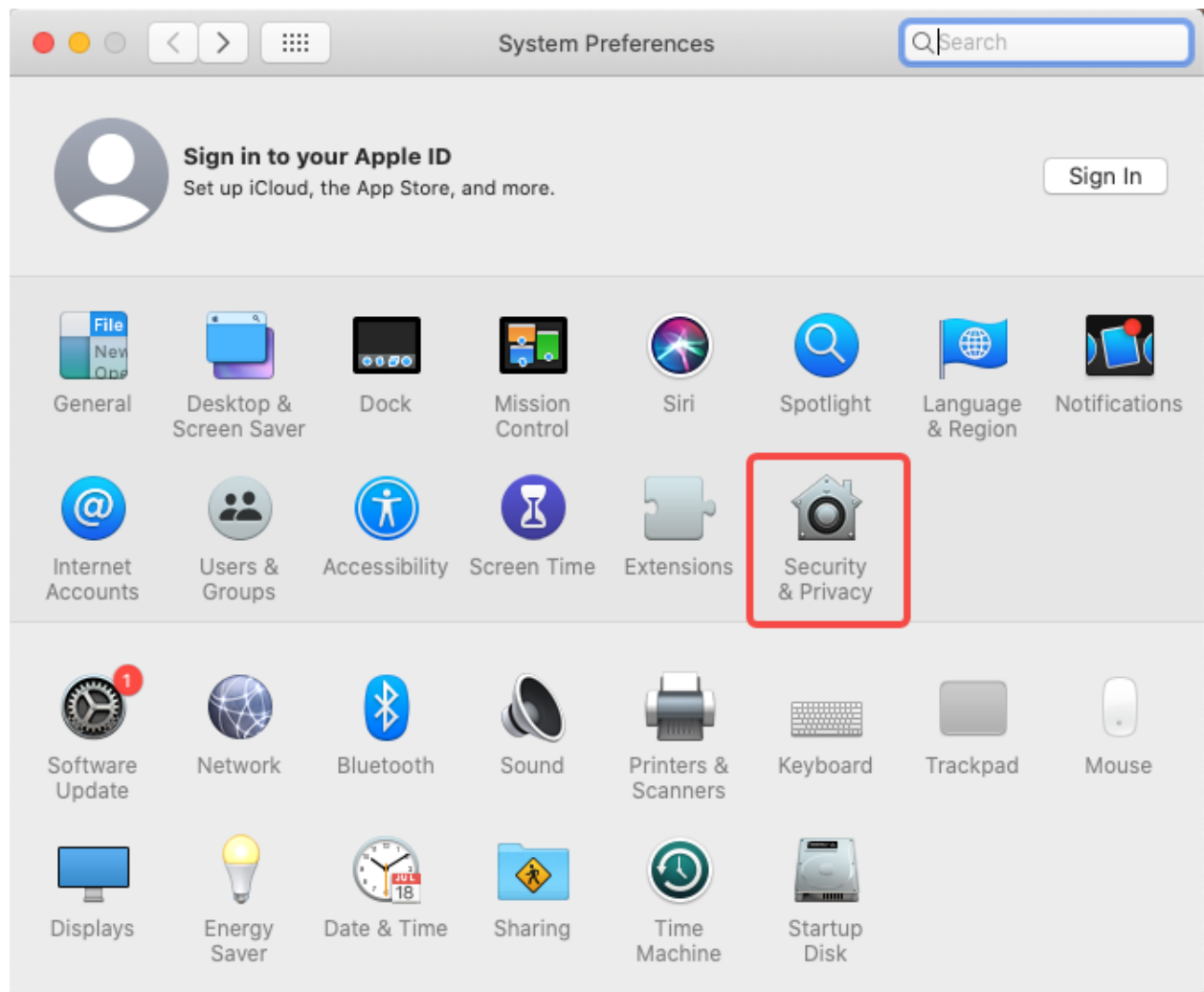


## How to Allow Chrome to Access Camera on Mac?

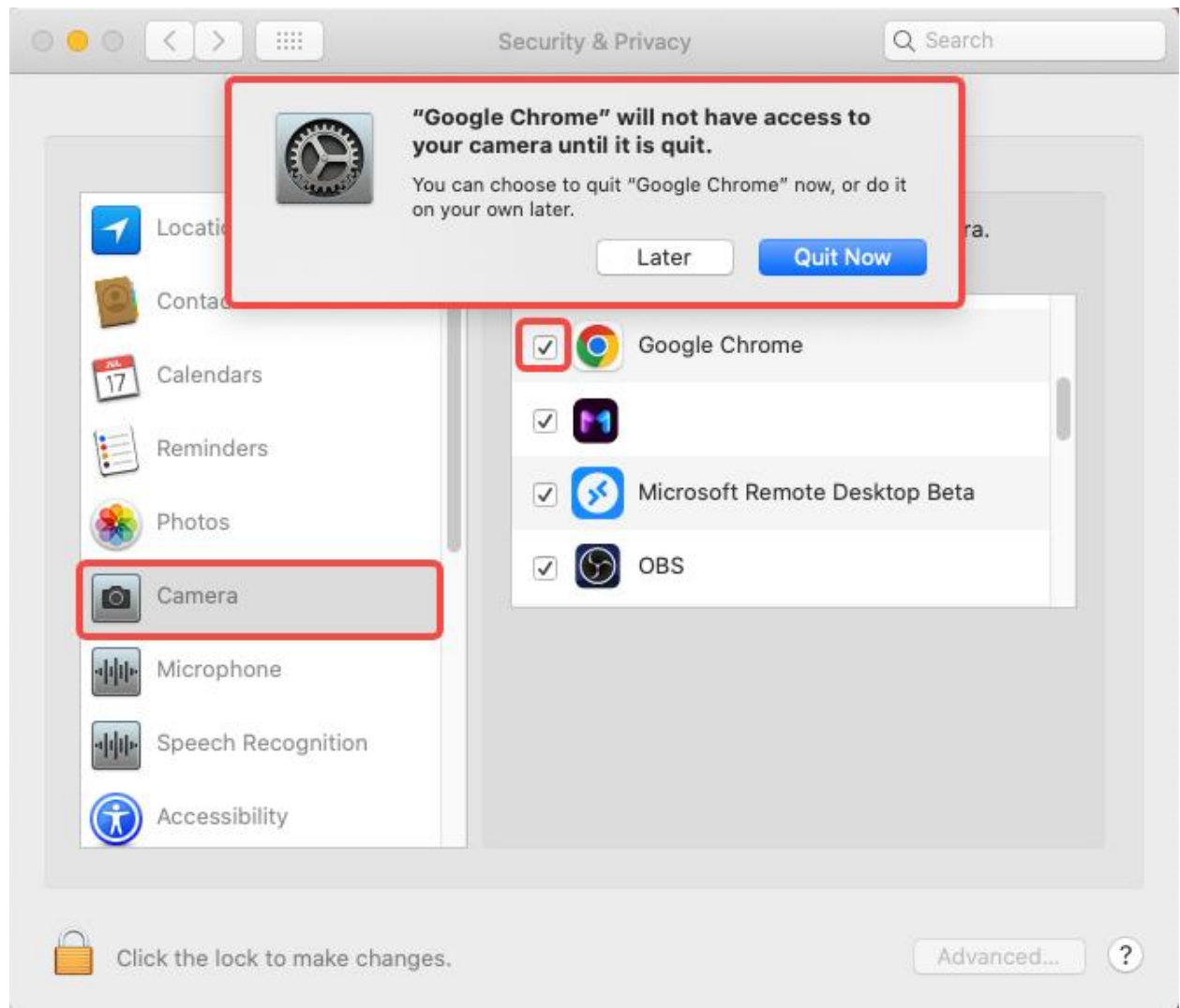
Here are some simple steps you can follow to allow Chrome to access the camera on Mac.

1. Click the **Apple icon** in the upper left corner, and go to **System Preferences**.
2. Click on **Security and Privacy**.

3. Navigate to the **Privacy**, which will be the last in the four tabs on the top.
4. Choose **Camera** from the left-hand column and tick the Google Chrome checkbox.



#### Allow Google Chrome to Access Mac Cameras

5. In a pop-up box, select the option to Quit Now to grant access.
6. If you don't see any (Camera or Google Chrome option), update your software and OS to the latest versions.  
Repeat steps 4 & 5 for the Microphone right below the Camera on the left side column.
